



Accessing Online Calamity Assignments

Vanlue Local School is permitted to use three (3) days of online lessons in the event that school is closed more than five (5) days. Should school be closed, days six (6) through eight (8) will be held on an online environment called Moodle. Should school close more than eight days, those days will be made up at school according to the calendar set by the Board of Education. Moodle is an online course management system that we are using to give students access to lessons in the event of school closures on days six (6) through eight (8). Students should have their work completed upon returning to school. Should a student not have online access, copies will be made for them and they will have up to two (2) weeks to complete the assignments for credit, though they should complete the assignments as soon as possible.

To access assignments on Moodle:

1. Go to <http://vanlueschool.org>
2. Under the Academics menu, select your teacher's name.
3. Listed under the teacher's name you should see a topic titled "Calamity Day Lesson."
4. To access your classes:
 - a. Elementary students, you will also need to click on your teacher's name for gym, art, music, and computer. Only complete the specials assignment for the class you would have had if school were in session.
 - b. Middle/High School courses are listed by teacher. You will need to visit all of your teachers to access your assignments.
5. Log in Moodle with your student Moodle username and password.
6. You may now access the lessons. Print off necessary work and bring them completed to school when we return. Turn in your assignments to your teachers for grading.
